

Canoe Or Kayak The Rio Grande

We provide a fleet of kayaks and canoes for your enjoyment, perfect for a leisurely afternoon on the Rio Grande River. As you paddle quietly along the lush jungle riverbanks, you'll feel deeply immersed in nature.

The river's gentle current makes paddling upstream or downstream easy, where you may encounter iguanas, howler monkeys, tropical birds, rolling tarpons, and a variety of indigenous wildlife.

Explore Scenic Hiking Trails

Copal Tree offers a variety of moderate hiking trails that lead to points of interest throughout the property. Explore the Chocolate Trail through our cacao plantation or take the Sugarcane Run, which winds around the sugarcane fields just outside the gates.

Along these trails, you may encounter a diverse range of birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and even tracks of larger nocturnal animals like tapirs and jaguars. You'll also discover various medicinal and edible plants and mushrooms.

We highly recommend hiking with a guide at least once; our knowledgeable guides are experts in the local flora and fauna and are skilled at spotting wildlife.



The Rio Grande River meanders through the property and 30,000 acres of protected land form its eastern boundary. From atop Big Hill, birdwatchers enjoy uninterrupted jungle views and sightings of soaring raptors. The organic gardens and citrus groves at the property's base also attract a variety of birds.

Our guides, avid bird watchers themselves, love sharing the rich avian life of Copal Tree and Belize. Mentored by leading experts like Dr. Lee Jones, author of "Birds of Belize," they offer a remarkable depth of avian knowledge.

Full-Day Scarlet Macaw Birding Tour

For bird enthusiasts, visiting the Scarlet Macaw Reserve at Red Bank Village is essential. Located in the Stann Creek District, Red Bank hosts Central America's largest gathering of scarlet macaws. From December to March, these stunning birds descend from their mountain nesting sites in the Chiquibul National Park to feed at lower elevations, allowing you to admire their vibrant red, yellow, and blue colors up close.

Red Bank is about 70 miles north along the Southern Highway, an hour and a half drive from Copal Tree Lodge. The journey through diverse ecosystems offers frequent opportunities to add species to your birding checklist.






